

1. **Genesis 1:1 "fab four"**: In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.
2. **John 1:1 "fab four"**: In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.
3. **John 1:14 "fab four"**: The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the one and only Son, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth
4. **John 3:16 "fab four"**: For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.
5. **Romans 3:23 "roman road"**: for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God
6. **Romans 6:23 "roman road"**: For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord
7. **Romans 5:8 "roman road"**: But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.
8. **Romans 10:9-10 "roman road"**: If you declare with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you profess your faith and are saved
9. **2 Timothy 3:16 "listening word of God"**: All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness
10. **Joshua 1:8 "listening word of God"**: Keep this Book of the Law always on your lips; meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do everything written in it. Then you will be prosperous and successful.
11. **Psalms 119:11 "listening word of God"**: I have hidden your word in my heart that I might not sin against you.
12. **Deuteronomy 6:6-7 "listening word of God"**: These commandments that I give you today are to be on your hearts. Impress them on your children. Talk about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up.
13. **Hebrews 4:12 "listening word of God"**: For the word of God is alive and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart.
14. **Hebrews 4:16 "listening word of God"**: Let us then approach God's throne of grace with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in our time of need
15. **1 John 5:14-15 "listening word of God"**: This is the confidence we have in approaching God: that if we ask anything according to his will, he hears us. And if we know that he hears us—whatever we ask—we know that we have what we asked of him.
16. **1 John 5:11-12 "inner peace"**: And this is the testimony: God has given us eternal life, and this life is in his Son. Whoever has the Son has life; whoever does not have the Son of God does not have life.
17. **John 14:1-3 "inner peace"**: "Do not let your hearts be troubled. You believe in God; believe also in me. My Father's house has many rooms; if that were not so, would I have told you that I am going there to prepare a place for you? And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come back and take you to be with me that you also may be where I am.
18. **John 14:6 "inner peace"**: Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.
19. **John 14:27 "inner peace"**: Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid.
20. **Isaiah 26:3 "inner peace"**: You will keep in perfect peace those whose minds are steadfast, because they trust in you.
21. **Isaiah 53:5-6 "inner peace"**: But he was pierced for our transgressions, he was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was on him, and by his wounds we are healed. We all, like sheep, have gone astray, each of us has turned to our own way, and the LORD has laid on him the iniquity of us all.
22. **1 Peter 1:3 "praise"**: Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! In his great mercy he has given us new birth into a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead
23. **Psalms 100:4-5 "praise"**: Enter his gates with thanksgiving and his courts with praise; give thanks to him and praise his name. For the LORD is good and his love endures forever; his faithfulness continues through all generations
24. **Revelation 4:11 "praise"**: "You are worthy, our Lord and God, to receive glory and honor and power, for you created all things, and by your will they were created and have their being."
25. **Matthew 6:33 "promises"**: But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.
26. **Romans 8:28 "promises"**: And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose.
27. **Jeremiah 29:11 "promises"**: For I know the plans I have for you," declares the LORD, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future.
28. **1 John 1:7,9 "promises"**: But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus, his Son, purifies us from all sin

If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.
29. **Proverbs 3:5-6 "promises"**: Trust in the LORD with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways submit to him, and he will make your paths straight.
30. **1 Corinthians 10:13 "promises"**: No temptation has overtaken you except what is common to mankind. And God is faithful; he will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear. But when you are tempted, he will also provide a way out so that you can endure it.

31. **Psalm 55:22 "promises"**: Cast your cares on the LORD and he will sustain you; he will never let the righteous be shaken.
32. **1 Peter 5:7 "promises"**: Cast all your anxiety on him because he cares for you.
33. **2 Chronicles 7:14 "obey holiness"**: if my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and I will forgive their sin and will heal their land.
34. **Romans 12:1-2 "obey holiness"**: Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God—this is your true and proper worship. Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is—his good, pleasing and perfect will.
35. **Romans 12:11-12 "obey holiness"**: Never be lacking in zeal, but keep your spiritual fervor, serving the Lord. Be joyful in hope, patient in affliction, faithful in prayer.
36. **Romans 12:18 "obey holiness"**: If it is possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone.
37. **2 Corinthians 9:7 "obey holiness"**: Each of you should give what you have decided in your heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver.
38. **Hebrews 10:25 "obey holiness"**: not giving up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but encouraging one another—and all the more as you see the Day approaching.
39. **Proverbs 1:7 "obey holiness"**: The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge, but fools despise wisdom and instruction.
40. **Proverbs 15:1 "obey holiness"**: A gentle answer turns away wrath, but a harsh word stirs up anger.
41. **Ephesians 5:18-21 "Holy Spirits role"**: Do not get drunk on wine, which leads to debauchery. Instead, be filled with the Spirit, speaking to one another with psalms, hymns, and songs from the Spirit. Sing and make music from your heart to the Lord, always giving thanks to God the Father for everything, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ.
42. **Galatians 5:22-23 "Holy Spirits role"**: But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law.
43. **Psalm 118:24 "joy"**: The LORD has done it this very day; let us rejoice today and be glad.
44. **Philippians 4:4-7 "joy"**: Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: Rejoice! Let your gentleness be evident to all. The Lord is near. Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.
45. **James 1:2-5 "joy"**: Consider it pure joy, my brothers and sisters, whenever you face trials of many kinds, because you know that the testing of your faith produces perseverance. Let perseverance finish its work so that you may be mature and complete, not lacking anything. If any of you lacks wisdom, you should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to you.
46. **Ephesians 2:8-10 "faith trusting"**: For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God— not by works, so that no one can boast. For we are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.
47. **Galatians 2:20 "faith trusting"**: I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I now live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.
48. **Colossians 3:15-17 "faith trusting"**: Let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, since as members of one body you were called to peace. And be thankful. Let the message of Christ dwell among you richly as you teach and admonish one another with all wisdom through psalms, hymns, and songs from the Spirit, singing to God with gratitude in your hearts. And whatever you do, whether in word or deed, do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him.
49. **Romans 1:16-17 "faith trusting"**: For I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of God that brings salvation to everyone who believes: first to the Jew, then to the Gentile. For in the gospel the righteousness of God is revealed—a righteousness that is by faith from first to last, just as it is written: "The righteous will live by faith."
50. **Psalm 56:3 "faith trusting"**: When I am afraid, I put my trust in you.
51. **Psalm 4:8 "faith trusting"**: In peace I will lie down and sleep, for you alone, LORD, make me dwell in safety.
52. **Hebrews 11:6 "faith trusting"**: And without faith it is impossible to please God, because anyone who comes to him must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who earnestly seek him.
53. **Matthew 28:18-20 "great commission"**: Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."
54. **Acts 1:8 "great commission"**: But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.

55. **Psalm 23 "Lord is my shepherd":** The LORD is my shepherd, I lack nothing. He makes me lie down in green pastures, he leads me beside quiet waters, he refreshes my soul.
He guides me along the right paths for his name's sake. Even though I walk through the darkest valley, I will fear no evil, for you are with me; your rod and your staff, they comfort me.
- You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies. You anoint my head with oil; my cup overflows. Surely your goodness and love will follow me all the days of my life, and I will dwell in the house of the LORD forever.
56. **Isaiah 9:6 "alpha and omega":** For to us a child is born, to us a son is given, and the government will be on his shoulders.
And he will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.
57. **Luke 2:10-12 "alpha and omega":** But the angel said to them, "Do not be afraid. I bring you good news that will cause great joy for all the people. Today in the town of David a Savior has been born to you; he is the Messiah, the Lord. This will be a sign to you: You will find a baby wrapped in cloths and lying in a manger."
58. **Acts 1:11 "alpha and omega":** "Men of Galilee," they said, "why do you stand here looking into the sky? This same Jesus, who has been taken from you into heaven, will come back in the same way you have seen him go into heaven."
59. **Revelation 21:1-2 "alpha and omega":** Then I saw "a new heaven and a new earth," for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away, and there was no longer any sea. I saw the Holy City, the new Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride beautifully dressed for her husband.
60. **Revelation 22:20 "alpha and omega":** He who testifies to these things says, "Yes, I am coming soon." Amen. Come, Lord Jesus
